> Committee Updates:

- After Prom: April 5th, 2025 (Sarah Rauker/Holly Beck).
 - Just sent out volunteer list, and tomorrow will go out directly to the Junior parents.
 - Can put it into the 'prom com' from Mr. Frank, goes out to all Juniors and Seniors. Also ask Lilah to now put the volunteer instead of the donate button at the top.
 - Getting random donations from the community. Should be getting thank you notes from Give Butter, and we also have paper thank you cards to send out after the prom.
 - Question can anchors be put in the walls of the gym, that could also be used later on? Stringing lights, drop cloth dividers, etc. Do have them in the cafetorium. Another option rental pipe and drape. Walk space on Friday, explore how to make a divider like with fabric and volleyball stands. Perhaps string lights from basketball hoops, tape anchor to bleachers. 2025 numbers from senior sunrise for ambient lighting. Will get measurements of couch from Ms Zema, to get a cover.

 - Maybe have an assistant (or Co) to keep load light. Stacey recommends someone who might have a background or love of graphic design and content creation
 - Suggestions from Mr. Frank to help fill the position:

Build a system moving forward. Could be a spring or summer project to set this up. Consider how to not have multiple asks for the same family.
