> Call to Order

➤ Officer Reports:

- President Report (Audra):
- Secretary's Report (Allison/Meredith):
 - Motion approved and passed
- Treasurer's Report (Katherine):
 - Quarter through the year. Still doing well.
 - Have spent \$3,600 more than brought in, but not concerned as we are just starting the capital campaign.
 - We have raised 22% of income, and spent 30% of expenses.
 - Did receive the Boulder county \$500 from a previous year.
 - Question how do we get funds that Katherine receives and move it to Give Butter? Also, who gets notes of appreciation (phone calls, hand written notes) at certain levels? We also have some corporate matches (Benevity, Google, etc.). Can we get reports from Give Butter? Everyone that donates in Give Butter gets a standard thank you level.
 - Action: Katharine will send those names to Judy to bring into Give Butter.
 - Action: With no email, print a tax receipt and mail with a thank you. Potentially create a generic new booster club gmail for each new contract without a email for tracking.
 - Action: Get thank you notes, develop a criteria for who gets hand written notes
 - Question after prom, random three \$1 charges. No clarity on where it came.
 - Motion approved and passed

> Allocations:

- PE department requests \$750 new archery targets, old ones are 5 years old and not working.
 Benefits 75 students, and would use all of PE budget. Motion approved and passed.
- Request from a parent volunteer in River Watch Club. Purchased 3 women waders and supplies for water testing recommended by River Watch organization. 16 students and supplies used for years to come. Request \$227.22. Motion approved and passed.
- Question What exactly is the \$1500 being used for CSU mountain camp used for? Included transportation, substitute teacher coverage, supplies. Bring down cost in general. School will follow up.

> Committee Updates:

- After Prom: April 5th 2025 (Sarah Rauker/Holly Beck).
 - Next year: The person who wrote the grant should present it to the Lyons Community Foundation as they would be able to communicate what happened more efficiently.
 - About 2k in budget, plus about 2k usually raised (historically), so 4k budget total
 - Some ideas being considered: pop balloon and get prize from local business; one big prize at end; goody bags with candy and coins to play arcade; maybe get a few extra prizes from Longmont; magician walking around a doing card tricks, caricature artist, if arcade with bigger games, photo booth with props. Maybe a mocktail 'specialty drinks' bar. Dutch brothers came once for free customize drinks. Root beer floats again. Do a google form survey to offer them choices on what they would prefer casino night, arcade, karaoke, etc. because it is all about them. Sarah will send to Savannah and Frank to get the survey form out. Let the students come with music list.
 - Pizza was not popular, maybe more snack food.
 - Would like to use Oskar Blues again.

Concession (Lynne/Meg/Kristen):

- Savannah Holmes is going to take over Lynne's position as the inventory manager as well as being the point person for concessions.
- We will still need a Shopper (Kristen's). Advertising a free Sam's Club membership is hopefully attractive. So if you could put it on the agenda, bring it up at the meeting, and have the communications team advertise it, that would be great! *** Ideally, we'd like to transition starting in January. Action: Ask Mr. Frank to put it out in email.
